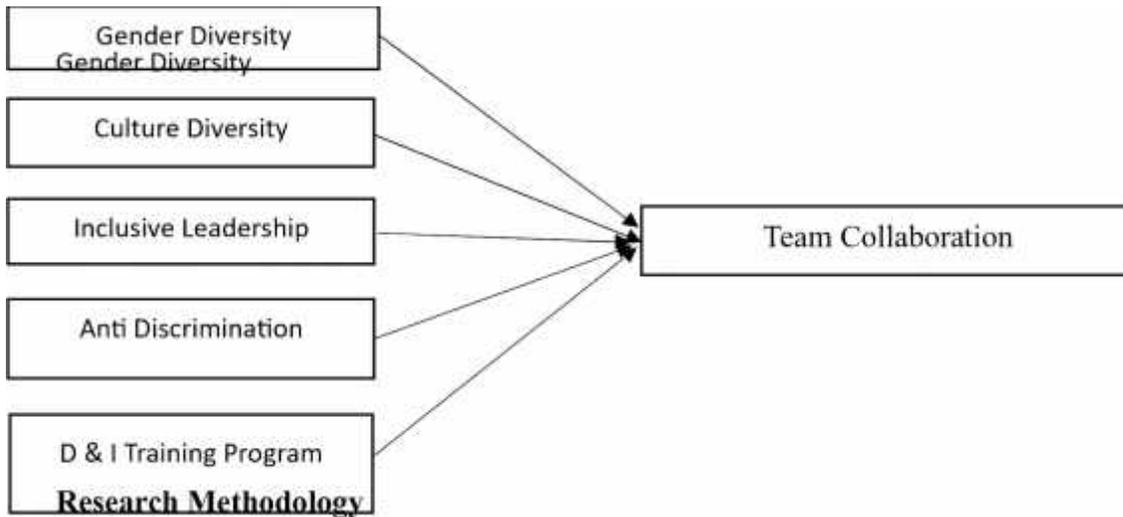
Review of Literature
